New Business

The request to locate the circle on the south side of the north/south parking area was presented. Opposition by Frank was discussed with the thinking that it would interfere with helicopter operation.

After a long discussion we all walked to the back of the field and using a measuring tape the location of the circle was shown. The alternative of locating the circle in the triangle behind the main shelter was discussed. Members returned to the meeting area where a motion was made by Jerry Guarch to allow the flying at the triangle area. Mauricio Figueroa seconded. Motion was voted and approved. The new control-line members will help establish the rules and the flying circle.

President's Note: Until permanent field rules are established, we will enforce the following rule: Control-Line flying may only take place at the designated area - triangle section behind the cooking shelter.
