Operation of Control-Line (U-Control) Model Aircraft

- 1. Pilot must abide by all AMA requirements, rules, and regulations regarding operation of Control-Line model aircraft.
- 2. Flying may only take place on the designated circle located Southeast center of the property.

New Business

Discussion of NO FLYING WHILE MOWING rules - Jose Sarmiento wanted clarification on the rule. He indicated that a couple of meetings ago it was said that flying could take place if mowing was taking place behind the canopies. The consensus was that the rule is to be strictly followed. **No flying, of any kind, will take place while mowing is taking place anywhere on the field.** Major concerns are related to liability issues. We do not want to be sued if a worker is injured by a flying model.
